GLENSIDE LAUNCHES IN SOUTH AUSTRALIA

The first homes to be built at Glenside have been approved by the South Australian State Planning Commission with registered buyers able to purchase just prior to the sales launch in February 2018.

The unveiling of the brand in late 2017 led to a sharp rise in the number of registrations of interest, with pre-launch marketing initiatives sustaining high demand and the number of registered prospects now running into the thousands.

Glenside will see the transformation of the 16-hectare site into a master-planned community with around 1,000 new dwellings and high quality public spaces linked to walking and cycling trails. Homes will be set in a lush green botanical environment including landscaped parks planted with 400 new trees, alongside sensitively restored heritage buildings.

Glenside is located on the CBD fringe, close to Adelaide's southern parklands and adjacent to the Frewville Shopping Centre which boasts the world's best independent supermarket. It's also just a few minutes from Burnside Village.

Initial site works for the \$400 million Glenside development started in June 2017, including construction of the development's sales centre and project office which is nearing completion.

FIRST RESIDENTS MOVE IN AT JACKSON GREEN

The first residents of Jackson Green are moving into their new architecturally designed homes in the master-planned community in Clayton South. The next residences are anticipated to be completed by mid 2018.

ELLENDALE TO REACH MILESTONE OF 100 HOMES AT CONSTRUCTION PHASE

There are over 70 homes currently under construction at Ellendale in Upper Kedron. The first settlements were completed in May 2017, and over 30 more homes are about to commence construction. Ellendale is quickly reaching a milestone of over 100 homes at the construction phase of Stage One.

Noted as Brisbane's newest master planned community, Ellendale has maintained its popularity since its first sales release in May 2016 and buyers have embraced Ellendale's vision as a premium, leafy village address that features quality home designs that complement the natural environment

Nestled within the existing neighbourhood of Upper Kedron, only 12 kilometres from Brisbane's CBD, Ellendale is adjacent to the South D'Aguilar National Park with approximately 40 per cent of the 227 hectare site being dedicated to Brisbane City Council as green space. CONSTRUCTION WELL UNDERWAY AT ST.A

Construction is well underway at St.A, our master-planned community in St Albans.

Civil construction is nearing completion across Stages 1–5 and housing construction is well underway. Led by building contractor Burbank, concrete slabs have been poured for the majority of the homes in Stages 2, 3 and 4. Framing and brickwork is now moving ahead on these stages.

Homes at St.A are architecturally designed and built to high standards, with carefully selected materials to achieve optimum energy performance ratings.

Our customers have recognised the value of these beautiful homes and demand has been strong, with the past four consecutive releases selling out within a week of release.

Civil construction is set to begin on the later stages of the St.A community in early 2018, which will pave the way for construction to begin on future town home releases.

St.A is located 16 kilometres from Melbourne's CBD, at the heart of the reinvigorated suburb of St Albans.



It is conveniently positioned within walking distance to Victoria University, the train station, the St Albans town centre and Alfrieda Street retail precinct, which have recently been rejuvenated by road level crossing removals and the train station upgrade.
