## **Local Indigenous artist transforms Byford on the Scarp**

Local Indigenous Yorga artist Connie Clinch has transformed the old water tank at Byford on the Scarp into a vibrant and energetic contemporary painting acknowledging the history of the land.

The artwork, commissioned by Cedar Woods, will be featured alongside new seating for residents and visitors to soak up the serene surroundings of the Ridge Adventure Park, located within the Byford on the Scarp community.

With a rich history, Connie's painting was inspired by Indigenous stories of the area that have since passed through generations. Infused with bright colours, her design centres around the Rainbow Bee-eater bird, who moves through the land while it nests and eats. The striking yellow and black features represent the bees, which symbolise the circle of life.

The artwork compliments the public spaces and streetscapes of Byford on the Scarp, which embody peace and tranquillity in a convenient community setting.

*Connie said she felt it was important to draw on the area's history, using her art to educate the community on the rich history of the Byford estate.*

*"Being a Mum myself, I'm all about getting my kids involved in the community and educated on our country's background. I felt this was a great opportunity to draw on our culture and showcase the rich history of our community in a bright and colourful way," says Connie.*

Cedar Woods Estate Sales Manager, Kaylene McTernan, said the estate has a responsibility to educate our residents on the history of this land and pay respect to its origins.
